



Bill Hill Scholarship Award

for advertising, Public Relations, Graphics &
Design, Marketing and Communications Majors

Purpose

The purpose of the AAFSC Bill Hill Scholarship is to honor our first local president and Silver Medal recipient with a college scholarship award, in his name, to a student who has shown a career interest in the advertising or related field.

Awards

One \$1,000 award will be available for one year only. No more than one scholarship will be awarded to the same individual. The scholarship will be paid directly to the recipients.

Eligibility

1. All applicants must be a full-time student at a local high school, college or university, reside in Brevard County, Florida, and be a US citizen.
2. High School applicants must be in a class or course related to advertising, marketing, communication, film, website development or other related track and graduating in 2023.
3. College applicants must be in an upper division advertising, marketing, communication, film, website development or other related track and slated for graduation not earlier than the following fall semester.
4. Applicants must fill in the entire application and provide all the requested materials.
5. Membership is not required but recommended. Students who are not currently members of AAFSC are invited to complete both applications (membership and scholarship). Student member dues are \$10 per year.

Selection Criteria

1. Demonstrated interest in advertising or a related field of study
2. Personal Statement
3. Sample of work (1 minimum)
4. Academic standing (minimum required cumulative GPA of 3.50)

Application Requirements

To be considered for an AAFSC Bill Hill Scholarship Award, applicants must complete an application and return it to AAFSC **by March 18**. The applicant must include:

1. A completed application form.
2. Two letters of recommendation with at least one from a teacher or school official.
3. Sample of your work (1 minimum) in any related advertising field of study as mentioned in the Eligibility statement above.
4. A current official academic transcript from local school as mentioned above.
5. Personal Statement: please include a 250-500 word statement describing your advertising/creative/marketing career goals.
